✓ The FSA WHAT??

You know the 4-digit PIN that you used to signed your FAFSA? Well, soon the PIN will be history! Instead, students and parents will need a **FSA ID**, username and password, to access all **Federal Student Aid** websites, including fafsa.gov and studentloans.gov.

✓ WHEN is this change happening?

The FSA ID is scheduled to replace the PIN on April 26th.

✓ WHY is it happening?

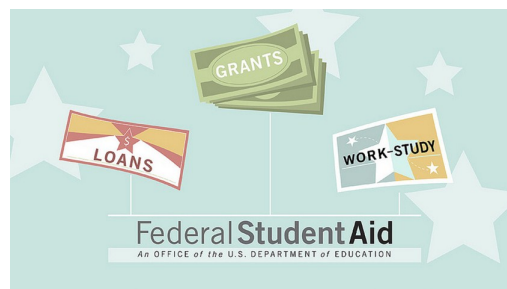
It's all about cyber security! Federal Student Aid wants to make sure the info you provide on the FAFSA is safe and secure and the FSA ID is the best way to do this.

✓ WHO does this change affect?

Anyone who had a PIN before will need to apply for a FSA ID. This includes high school seniors, current college students AND parents.

✓ HOW will I apply for a FSA ID?

A link to the FSA ID application page will be posted on all FSA websites at the end of April. We encourage you to apply for your new FSA ID ASAP if you will need to do entrance loan counseling and sign a MPN to borrow federal student loans for college.
